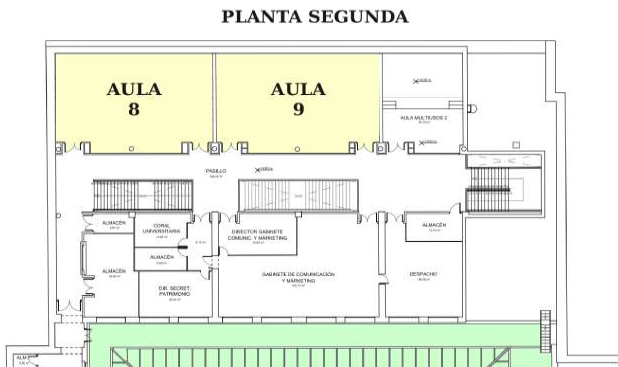
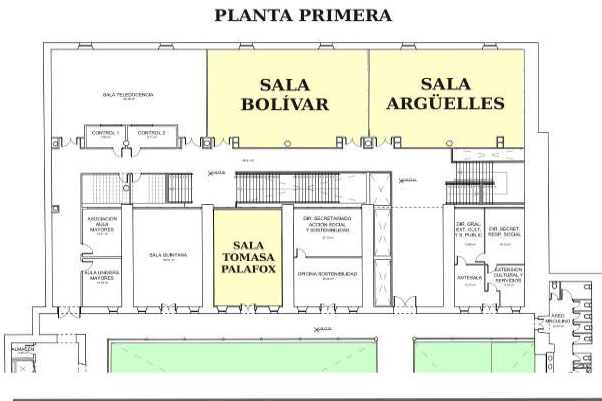
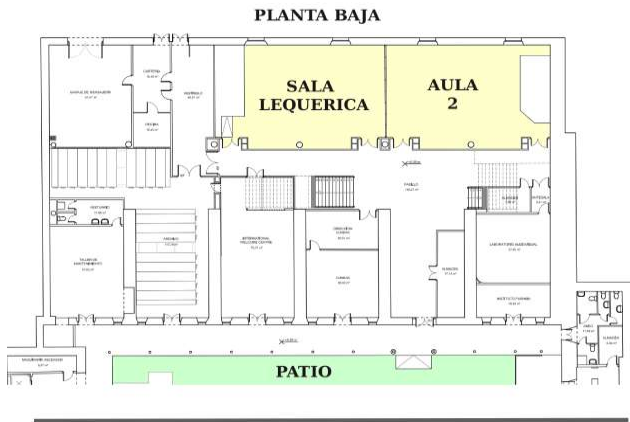

Universidad de Cádiz (Edificio Constitución 1812)

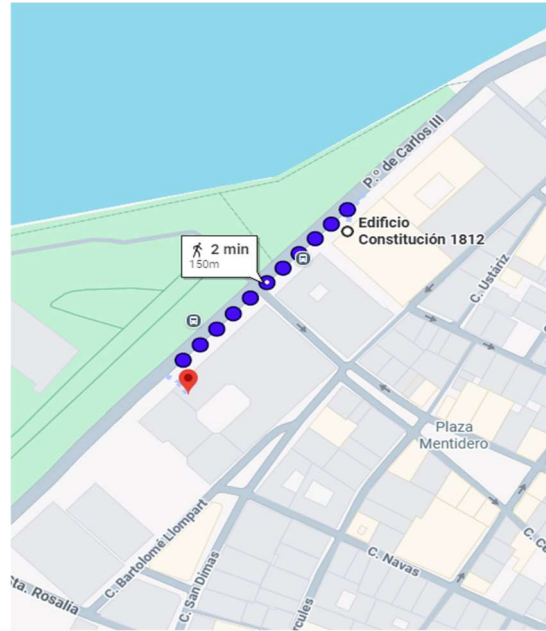
